Mark 10:45-52, "For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." ⁴⁶ Then they came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples, together with a large crowd, were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus (which means "son of Timaeus"), was sitting by the roadside begging. ⁴⁷When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

⁴⁸Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" ⁴⁹ Jesus stopped and said, "Call him." So they called to the blind man, "Cheer up! On your feet! He's calling you." ⁵⁰ Throwing his cloak aside, he jumped to his feet and came to Jesus.

⁵¹ "What do you want me to do for you?" Jesus asked him. The blind man said, "Rabbi, I want to see." ⁵² "Go," said Jesus, "your faith has healed you." Immediately, he received his sight and followed Jesus along the road.

2. Unusual Sensitivity to the Spirit

Mark 10:47, When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

3. Cried Out in **Desperation**

Mark 10:47b, ...he began to shout, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!"

4. Fought Bravely Against Opposition

Mark 10:48, Many rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!"

5. Lived With **Total** Abandonment

Mark 10:50, Throwing his cloak aside, he jumped to his feet and came to Jesus.

6. Gladly Followed Jesus

Mark 10:52 (KJV), And Jesus said unto him, "Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole." And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
