Acts - To the Ends of the Earth // God's Leaders for His Church

Read Acts 13:1-3

1. Compare and contrast how the gospel was spread in Acts chapters 1-8 with what is about to happen in chapters 13 and beyond.
2. Read Matthew 28:18-20. What is the great commission and who was it for?
3. Why do you think Luke specifically mentions that the church was fasting? What is the importance of fasting within the church? Talk about a time that you fasted and why you did as well as the results.
4. What was the response of Barnabus and Saul to the call of the spirit to leave their church? And what was the response of the people?
5. The church leaders from Acts 13 were a diverse group of individuals; do we see this level of diversity in our church today? Discuss why/why not.
6. How can Cornerstone become more outwardly focused as the church in Antioch had become? What would that mean for you personally to live out an external focus for the sake of Jesus?
7. Pastor Tim said, '*God does not call people who are doing nothing for His glory, He calls people who are faithfully laboring for His glory*' Do you agree with this, and if so, how are you serving the Lord right now?
