DAY 1 Read Joshua 24:14-16

[14] "So fear the Lord and serve him wholeheartedly. Put away forever the idols your ancestors worshiped when they lived beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt. Serve the Lord alone. [15] But if you refuse to serve the Lord, then choose today whom you will serve. Would you prefer the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates? Or will it be the gods of the Amorites in whose land you now live? But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord." [16] The people replied, "We would never abandon the Lord and serve other gods.

Joshua 24:14-16 NLT

- This passage of scripture speaks of legacy. What is the most significant spiritual legacy you are leaving for the next generation of your home.

Application:

- If covenants are so easily broken in our culture, how does that change the way you see God's covenant with his people?
- If you walked through your home, how many idols do you think you could count?

DAY 2 Read Joshua 24:14-16

Application:

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DAY 3 Read Joshua 24:16-20, James 1:17

[16] The people replied, "We would never abandon the Lord and serve other gods. [17] For the Lord our God is the one who rescued us and our ancestors from slavery in the land of Egypt. He performed mighty miracles before our very eyes. As we traveled through the wilderness among our enemies, he preserved us. [18] It was the Lord who drove out the Amorites and the other nations living here in the land. So we, too, will serve the Lord, for he alone is our God." [19] Then Joshua warned the people, "You are not able to serve the Lord, for he is a holy and jealous God. He will not forgive your rebellion and your sins. [20] If you abandon the Lord and serve other gods, he will turn against you and destroy you, even though he has been so good to you."

[17] Whatever is good and perfect is a gift coming down to us from God our Father, who created all the lights in the heavens. He never changes or casts a shifting shadow.

Application:

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DAY 5 Read Joshua 24:19-28

[19] Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. [20] Human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires. [21] So get rid of all the filth and evil in your lives, and humbly accept the word God has planted in your hearts, for it has the power to save your souls.

[22] But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves. [23] For if you listen to the word and don't obey, it is like glancing at your face in a mirror.

[24] You see yourself, walk away, and forget what you look like. [25] But if you look carefully into the perfect law that sets you free, and if you do what it says and don't forget what you heard, then God will bless you for doing it.

[26] If you claim to be religious but don't control your tongue, you are fooling yourself, and your religion is worthless. [27] Pure and genuine religion in the sight of God the Father means caring for orphans and widows in their distress and refusing to let the world corrupt you.
