The Mission of a Christian (Colossians 1:9-14, 1 Corinthians 2:12-16, Galatians 1:10)

- 1. Paul prays that believers will be filled with the knowledge of God's will. How can we actively seek and discern God's will in our daily lives? (Colossians 1:9)
- 2. How does knowing God's will help us walk in a manner worthy of the Lord? (Colossians 1:10)
- 3. <u>Galatians 1:10</u> talks about seeking the favor of God rather than people. How can we guard against people-pleasing in our faith journey?

The Mark of a Christian (Colossians 1:9-14, Matthew 7, Acts 5:41, Galatians 5)

- 1. What does it mean to "bear fruit" as a Christian? (Colossians 1:10, Matthew 7)
- 2. How has your knowledge of God grown over time? What are some ways to continue increasing in this knowledge? (Colossians 1:10)
- 3. Acts 5:41 describes the disciples rejoicing even in suffering. How can we develop a persevering walk in our faith?
- 4. Joy is a gift of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5). How can we maintain joy in difficult circumstances?

The Means of a Christian (Colossians 1:9-14)

- 1. What does it mean that God has "qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints"? (Colossians 1:12)
- 2. How has God set us free from darkness, and how does this freedom impact our daily choices? (Colossians 1:13)
- 3. <u>Colossians 1:14</u> reminds us that we have redemption and forgiveness in Christ. How can this truth shape the way we view our past mistakes and failures?
