5 Day Personal Devotional

Day 1: Redemption Fulfilled in Christ

"I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel." **Genesis 3:15**

Adam's fall in the Garden of Eden introduced sin into the world, shattering the perfect harmony that once existed. Yet, God, in His great love and mercy, promised redemption. This promise is fulfilled in Jesus, who came to crush the serpent's head and reverse the curse of sin. His resurrection is a powerful testament to God's faithfulness and His ability to restore creation to its original glory. As believers, we are called to live out the redeemed life, experiencing freedom from sin and the hope of eternal life. The redemption we have in Christ is not merely a distant theological concept. It is a present reality that transforms our daily lives.

Reflection: Is there an area of your life impacted by sin and the curse? What would it look like for you to repent and turn from sin to trust Christ?

Prayer Focus: Pray the Lord would give you eyes to see your sin and a sensitive heart to repent. Pray for the Lord would give you a deeper knowledge of Jesus and His Love.



Day 2: Resurrection as the Defining Reality

"But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive." **1 Corinthians**

15:20-22

The resurrection of Jesus is not merely an event in history; it is the defining reality of this world. It signifies the defeat of sin, shame, and fear, and the restoration of God's creation. Because Jesus is alive, we have the power to resist sin, endure suffering, and walk in godliness. This power is not our own but comes from the same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead, living within us. As Christ has been made alive, so we are made alive by trusting in Him.

Reflection: What difference does the resurrection of Jesus make in your daily life? What area of your life needs to be affected by the resurrection power of the Holy Spirit?

Prayer Focus: Pray the Lord would continually impact your life with the resurrection power of the Holy Spirit.



Day 3: Walking in Newness of Life

“We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.” **Romans 6:4**

Every day is an opportunity to walk in the newness of life that the resurrection offers. This means living with bold faith, loving others deeply, worshiping sincerely, and serving humbly. For those who trust in Jesus, our daily lives are infused with the extraordinary power of a risen Savior, transforming ordinary moments into opportunities for His glory. As we embrace this new life, we become vessels of His love and grace to those around us.

Reflection: What specific actions can you take to reflect the resurrection power in your daily interactions?

Prayer Focus: Thank the Lord for the power that gives us new life in Christ. Pray that those around you would see His resurrection power in you and give glory to Christ.



Day 4: Embracing Fearlessness in Christ

"Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." **Isaiah 41:10**

In the garden of Jesus' resurrection, the angel told the women not to be afraid. This contrasts sharply with the fear that gripped Adam and Eve in the first garden. With sin defeated at the cross, believers are invited to live without fear, knowing that Jesus has paid for our sins. This invitation to fearlessness is a call to trust in the victory of Christ and to live confidently in the assurance of His love and power.

Reflection: What fears do you face in life? Consider how Jesus' death and resurrection give us hope that erases fear.

Prayer Focus: Pray the Lord would help you know the power of resurrection and the hope that erases fear.



Day 5: Living in the Reality of Hope

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you." **1 Peter 1:3-4**

The empty tomb is a reminder of the hope we have in Christ. It assures us that anxiety, fear, doubt, and disappointment do not have the last word—Jesus does, and His Word is life. The resurrection changes everything, offering us a new perspective on our circumstances and a renewed sense of purpose. As we embrace this hope, we are called to share it with others, becoming witnesses of the transformative power of the risen Christ. This hope is not just for us but is meant to be shared with a world in need.

Reflection: Who in your life needs to hear about the hope of the resurrection? How can you share this hope with them in a meaningful way today?

Prayer Focus: Pray the Lord would help you to walk daily in the hope for eternal resurrection.
