In your own words, describe the image of God.

Read the following passage and discuss what it means to you.

John 1:14

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Describe how awesome it is for our God to subject himself to all the frailties of living in a human body.

Do we really believe that although he was really God – in a body – that although he had all this power and authority, this all-knowing, all-loving God decided that the best way to save us from our own sins, the best way to spare us from his own punishment, was to subject himself to extreme torture and execution – for us, taking our place?

What does it mean to pledge our allegiance to Jesus?

Read the passage and discuss the mystery “Christ in you.”

Colossians 1:24 - 27

Now I rejoice in what I am suffering for you, and I fill up in my flesh what is still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the church. I have become its servant by the commission God gave me to present to you the word of God in its fullness— the mystery that has been kept hidden for ages and generations, but is now disclosed to the Lord's people. To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

How does the mystery, “Christ in you” affect your daily life?

Colossians 2:2

My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ,
