 4. What is the problem Job is wrestling with in [Job 9:2](#), [Job 4:17](#), and [Job 25:4](#)? Do you see any evidence in your life of this struggle? Do you see any evidence in the world that people everywhere wrestle with this question?
 5. Read the following verses in the Gospel of John, record your insights about the simplicity of receiving and acting on the Gospel message as discussed by Paul in [Romans 10](#), as well as [John 1:12](#), [John 2:22](#), [John 3:36](#), [John 5:24](#), [John 11:25](#), [John 12:42](#), and [John 20:31](#).
 6. Why do you think the simplicity of the gospel message is a stumbling block for so many people?
 7. What promise does Jesus make related to confessing that He is Lord? ([Matthew 10:32](#), [Romans 10:9](#))
