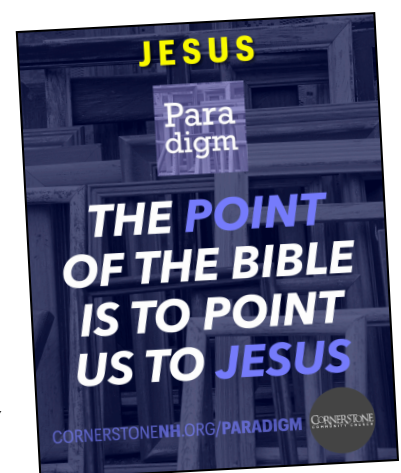
We all, like sheep, have gone astray,

From Part One: **Beginnings**

Jesus was there at the beginning, forming & filling creation.

He existed in the beginning with God. God created everything through him, – John 1:2-3a NLT

Salvation through Jesus was promised at the fall of humanity.

“...he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.”
– Genesis 3:15b NIV

God’s plan focused on a family through which Jesus would come into the world.

The Lord had said to Abram, “...All the families on earth will be blessed through you.” – Genesis 12:1-3 NLT

Part Two: **Rescue**

Jesus is God’s provision to rescue us from the power of sin & death, prefigured in the passover.



Applying the _____ Principle

PASSOVER	OLD TESTAMENT PASSOVER
1 Instruction to Sacrifice	“Take...a lamb...and...kill it” (Exodus 12:3,6)
2 Condition of Sacrifice	“Your lamb shall be without blemish” (Exodus 12:5)
3 Reason for Sacrifice	“I will execute judgment” (Exodus 12:12)
4 Application of Sacrifice	“Every man shall take for himself a lamb” (Exodus 12:3)
5 Result of Sacrifice	“The Lord will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you” (Exodus 12:23)

PASSOVER	NEW TESTAMENT PASSOVER
1 Instruction to Sacrifice	“Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world” (John 1:29)
2 Condition of Sacrifice	“...the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot” (1 Peter 1:19)
3 Reason for Sacrifice	“And...it is appointed for men to die once, but after this is the judgment” (Hebrews 9:27)
4 Application of Sacrifice	“Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved” (Acts 4:12)
5 Result of Sacrifice	“There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus” (Romans 8:1)

Christ, our Passover Lamb, has been sacrificed for us.
– 1 Corinthians 5:7c NLT

“But this is the new covenant I will make with the people of Israel after those days,” says the LORD. “I will put my instructions deep within them, and I will write them on their hearts.
