The Jesus Way - A Relationship with the World

Jesus consistently showed special care, dignity, and compassion toward people others overlooked or pushed to the margins.

He invites His followers to live with the same outward-facing posture.

Awareness

Jesus sees the people around Him and responds to their needs.

Read Matthew 9:35–36; Luke 10:30–37; John 4:4–10

- Who do you tend to overlook, avoid, or move past in your daily rhythms?
- What situations or people in your community stir compassion in you—and which ones don't?
- What might it look like to slow down enough to notice the needs God has already placed in your path?

Blessing

Jesus looks for ways to make the world around Him better.

Read Mark 10:13–16; Mark 1:40–42; Luke 5:29–32;

Matthew 11:28–30

- Where has God positioned you to be a blessing—at work, in your neighborhood, at school, or online?
- What is one small, tangible way you could bring hope, dignity, or help to someone this week?
- How might generosity, kindness, or hospitality reflect the heart of Jesus to others?

Engagement

Jesus welcomes others into His life and intentionally participates in theirs.

Read Luke 5:27–32; Luke 19:1–10; Luke 4:38–40,

- Who in your life feels “outside” your normal circle—but whom Jesus might be inviting you to engage?
- What fears or assumptions make it hard to move toward people who are different from you?
- What would it look like to practice presence—listening, eating, or spending time—without an agenda?

Sharing

Jesus lives and speaks in ways that point people to His Father in Heaven.

Read Matthew 5:14–16; John 17:13–19; Mark 10:17–21

- How does your everyday life reflect what you believe about God?
- When has God’s grace or faithfulness been real in your story?
- Who might God be inviting you to gently point toward Him through your words or actions?

Following the Jesus Way

Jesus shows us that loving the world doesn’t mean standing at a distance—it means moving toward people with humility, compassion, and truth.

- Which of these rhythms—Awareness, Blessing, Engagement, or Sharing—comes most naturally to you?
- Which one might Jesus be inviting you to grow in right now?
- What is one intentional step you can take this week to love the world the way Jesus does?
