Discussion Questions: Read Joshua 24:14-16

- 1. This passage of scripture speaks of legacy. In three sentences or fewer, describe the most significant spiritual legacy you are leaving for the next generation of your home.
- 2. Discuss this statement: "The pagan gods polluted the nation of Israel and they began carrying the baggage of false gods as a people defined by the one true God." How are we different or the same?

Read Joshua 24:16-20, James 1:17

- 3. How often do you find yourself having to choose between culture and God's Word in your home? How would your family describe what it looks like when you're choosing whom you will serve?
- 4. Explain what you heard when PK said, "Trusting God for the good He has done is not enough." Can you describe your view of God when everything seems like it's falling apart?

Read Joshua 24:19-28

5. If the Old Testament is painting a picture that we will never get to God on our own, how special is it to you that God would choose to make a covenant with His people, even if the people would break it?

Application:

- If covenants are so easily broken in our culture, how does that change the way you see God's covenant with his people?
- If you walked through your home, how many idols do you think you could count?
