ACTS 20:17-37

MISSION AND GRACE

Introduction:

Key Question: What is needed to be a faithful missionary?

Context:

End of Paul's 3rd missionary journey. 3 episodes in Acts 20:2-21:17 that make up the 2nd part of Paul's mission in Ephesus

- Visit to believers' in Macedonia, Achaia, and Asia (20:2-12)

- Journey from Troas to Miletus and meeting the Ephesian elders (20:13-38)

- Travel to Jerusalem: 21:1-17)

Main Theme 20:17-38:

Paul presents himself as a model missionary by saying farewell to the Ephesian elders by reviewing his mission in Asia, previewing his mission to Jerusalem, and reviewing his mission in Ephesus. Paul says that his mission is to serve Christ, focused enduring deadly opposition and trials, and by testifying to and preaching the whole plan of God, which involves repentance and faith, the grace of God, and the kingdom of God. He then exhorts the Ephesian elders to watch themselves the church and watch out for false teachers (from outside and inside) and concludes with a commendation of God's grace in Christ.

Main Purpose: For the readers to be assured that God' mission continues because of Paul's model and applying Paul's exhortation and commendation.

1. PAUL'S MISSION AS A MODEL (20:18-27)

Paul serves Christ by enduring opposition and preaching and testifying to the whole plan of God which involves both public and private teaching of the need for repentance and faith, the Gospel of God's grace, and how it fulfils the whole plan of God.

2. PAUL'S APPLICATION ABOUT MISSION (20:28-35)

Paul exhorts the pastors/elders to keep watch over themselves and the flock of the church of God because:

- a. it has been bought by His Own (Son's) blood,
- b. there are fierce wolves outside and inside to devour the sheep.

Paul also blesses the pastors by commanding them to the message of God's grace and concludes with his and Christ's examples of grace.

Conclusion:

BTPC needs to support faithful missionaries , that is, those who adopt Paul's model.
