

GOD, JUST TELL ME

How God Guides Us Into His Will

Consider how God is revealing His will to you through:

Open Doors

- What open door is God placing before you?
- Is there an opportunity, relationship, ministry, or challenge that God may be inviting you to step into even if it won't be easy? (an open door doesn't mean the absence of opposition)
- Identify one open door God has placed before you. Instead of waiting until you know exactly how it will turn out, prayerfully take one step through the door.

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Closed Doors

- What closed door are you struggling to accept?
- Is there a *no* in your life that you need to stop fighting?
- Could God be using this closed door to direct you toward something you can't yet see?
- Identify a closed door and pray: "God, help me trust that Your *no* may be leading me toward a better yes."

Frustrated Plans

- Name a plan that isn't unfolding the way you wanted.
- Instead of asking, "Why isn't this working?" ask, "God, where are You leading me through this?"
- Are you willing to take the next step without seeing the entire journey?

Everyday Choices

- Instead of waiting for a supernatural sign, make the most faithful choice you can, and trust God with the outcome?
- Use Psalm 32:8 to help you trust God with everyday choices: God says, *I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you.*
