<sup>49</sup> "And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. <u>But stay in the city</u> until you are clothed with power from on high." ~Luke 24:49 ESV

<sup>4</sup>And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father,... ~Acts 1:4 NKJV

## 1. WHERE DID THEY WAIT?

<sup>12</sup>Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey. <sup>13</sup>And when they had entered, they went up into the upper room where they were staying ~Acts 1:12-13 NKJV

<sup>52</sup>*And they worshiped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy,* <sup>53</sup>*and were continually in the temple* praising and blessing God. Amen. ~Luke 24:52-53 NKJV

<sup>46</sup>So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house... ~Acts 2:46 NKJV

<sup>42</sup>And daily in the temple, and in every house, they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ.

~Acts 5:42 NKJV

<sup>35</sup>Then one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, and saying, <sup>36</sup>"Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?" <sup>37</sup>Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' <sup>38</sup>This is the first and great commandment. <sup>39</sup>And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' <sup>40</sup>On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets." ~Matthew 22:35-40 NKJV
