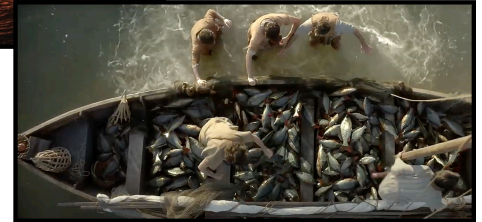
For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him. – Luke 5:9 NLT
