So the people of Israel ate manna for forty years until they arrived at the land where they would settle. They ate manna until they came to the border of the land of Canaan.

When he went into the Tabernacle of the Covenant the next day, he found that Aaron's staff, representing the tribe of Levi, had sprouted, budded, blossomed, and produced ripe almonds!

Manna = Disobedience

Some of the people went out anyway on the seventh day, but they found no food. The Lord asked Moses, "How long will these people refuse to obey my commands and instructions? They must realize that the Sabbath is the Lord's gift to you."

The Atonement Cover or Mercy Seat Covered Israel's Disobedience, Rebellion, and Idolatry.

- Manna = Disobedience
- Aaron's Rod that Budded = Rebellion

Place these staffs in the Tabernacle in front of the Ark containing the tablets of the Covenant, where I meet with you. Buds will sprout on the staff belonging to the man I choose. Then I will finally put an end to the people's murmuring and complaining against you.

The Atonement Cover or Mercy Seat Covered Israel's Disobedience, Rebellion, and Idolatry.

- Manna = Disobedience
- Aaron's Rod that Budded = Rebellion
- The Ten Commandments = Idolatry
